Step 3: Follow Up with Lawmakers

- Call your representatives' offices to confirm receipt
- Use the Advocacy Talking Points to engage officials effectively

3. Sending Letters & Emails to Lawmakers

Document C: Pre-Written Email & Letter Templates for Lawmakers

How to Take Action:

Select one of three options to contact lawmakers:

- Option 1: Formal Email Template for state and federal representatives
- Option 2: Handwritten or Mailed Letter Template for traditional advocacy
- Option 3: Resolution Draft for local councils or state legislatures to introduce mural recognition

Use this document when:

- Sending emails or letters to lawmakers
- Encouraging local leaders to introduce mural recognition legislation
- Seeking formal government adoption of the mural

4. Signing & Collecting Petitions

Document D: Official Petition for the Recognition of the USA 250th Anniversary Mural

This petition allows supporters to gather physical signatures at community events, schools, and public spaces.

How to Collect Signatures:

- Print multiple copies of the Official Petition
- Gather signatures from supporters in your community
- Direct people to the QR code for online petition access
